

STUDENT LOCKER AGREEMENT

The current fee is €20 per academic year, or course duration, whichever is the shorter, with €10 of that refundable on return of the locker key within 14 days of completion of the course, or termination of the academic year. (The second last week in May is typically the last week of the academic year. All keys should be returned by the second week in June at the latest.)

Lockers will be opened by the administration team at every mid-term break, and the end of each academic term, and if applicable, on completion of a 'short course' (defined below).

Short Courses

Students studying courses designed to be less than that of a full academic year, are entitled to a locker on the premises, as according to the Equal Status act 2000. No discrimination shall be held. However, if the course is such that no materials are brought in and out of college on a daily basis, the student must state the reasons for which they require a locker. Should the administration team deem these reasons suitable at their discretion, and a locker is readily available, a key may be issued, subject to the general terms and conditions and usage policy.

Your locker shall NEVER contain the following:

- Explosive or combustible material
- Perishable goods
- Any item considered as a weapon outlined in the Firearms and Offensive Weapons Act 1990
- Any prohibited or offensive material
- Alcohol or non-prescriptive drugs
- Active electronic goods or battery operated products
- Material or artefacts a Lecturer has explicitly expressed that should not be on college property
